I have performed > 4000 procedures in:

- **Bariatric Surgery** (laparoscopic/open gastric bypass, laparoscopic sleeve gastrectomies, gastric band insertion, revisional surgery, intragastric balloon)
- **Robotic Surgery** (robotic gastrectomies, Heller's myotomies, cholecystectomies, fundoplication, gastric electrical stimulator insertions)
- **HPB Surgery** (lap/open cholecystectomies +/- i.o. cholangiogram +/- bile duct exploration, Whipples and pancreatic resections, splenectomies, major and minor hepatic resection, bile duct reconstruction)
- **Colorectal Surgery** (lap/open colonic resections, high and low anterior resections with TME for rectal cancer, APR, Hartmann's procedures, surgery for IBD, stoma surgery, surgery for anorectal diseases)

Surgical Training

My surgical training started in 2002 with 6 years of training rotations at Registrar level at the **University Hospital of Siena (Italy)**, which is a tertiary care hospital covering major surgical procedures of a 500.000 peoples recruitment area. During my surgical training, I spent 1 month in the Department of Colorectal Surgery at the **Cleveland Clinic, Weston, Miami Florida (USA)**.

In 2006, I spent a period of 4 months as Surgical and Endoscopic Fellow at the **Institut Paoli-Calmettes in Marseille (France)**, which is a referral UGI and HPB cancer Centre in the South of France.

From 2007 to February 2011 and subsequently from October 2011 to January 2012, I worked in the **Oxford Radcliffe Hospitals NHS Trust**. During this period, I worked mainly in Colorectal, UGI and Bariatric Surgery between the John Radcliffe and Churchill Hospitals at Registrar and Senior Fellow level.

From February to October 2011, I worked at the **Broomfield Hospital in Chelmsford** as UGI Fellow, where I was involved in a wide range of surgical procedures for UGI cancers, benign UGI diseases and emergencies.

From January 2012 to October 2012, I worked as Senior Fellow in Surgical Oncology at **The Royal Marsden Hospital in Chelsea**, and my clinical practice was focused on the management and treatment of patients with UGI and HPB cancers as well as retroperitoneal sarcomas, gaining further experience in complex oncological and multivisceral resections.

From October 2012 to October 2013, I was working as Senior Fellow in HPB Surgery and Liver Transplant at **St. James's University Hospital in Leeds**. I was involved in clinical management and surgical treatment of benign and cancer HPB patients as well as multiorgan retrievals and liver and kidney transplants.

From October 2013 to October 2014, I was the Bariatric Fellow (Ethicon Fellowship) at the **Imperial College London**. I was involved in the management of bariatric patients with high level of independence and responsibility, including on call commitments for bariatric emergencies.

Current employment

Since October 2014, I have been appointed as **Consultant Upper GI and Bariatric Surgeon working at the Broomfield Hospital, Chelmsford**.

I work in a team of five Consultants forming a Regional Oesophago-Gastric Centre and providing treatment for patients with oesophageal and gastric cancer, and complex benign upper gastro-intestinal pathologies to a population of over one million in Essex and Suffolk. We perform approximately 100 operations/year for patients with oesophago-gastric cancer.

I have performed independent theatre lists for Upper GI cancers and benign diseases, GI endoscopy lists and emergency cover for general surgery for more than six years.

My clinical practice ranges from complex open multivisceral resections for advanced tumours to minimally invasive operations for benign and malignant pathologies.

I have experience in advanced laparoscopy for complex benign UGI pathologies such as repair of large para-oesophageal hernias and common bile duct explorations.

I perform a large number of general surgery operations (such as laparoscopic/open hernia repairs, laparoscopic cholecystectomies, anti-reflux surgery, etc).

I have a drive for surgical innovation and I have experience in 3D laparoscopy with Olympus and B.Braun Einstein Vision systems, and robotic surgery with daVinci robot.
